

Chapter Policies
Concho Valley Chapter of Basketball Officials
2013-2014

- 1) You are responsible for your assigned game schedule
- 2) The Referee is the crew chief. You are responsible for contacting the Referee at least one day prior to game day. Travel arrangements are the Referee's decision.
- 3) The Secretary must approve all game assignment changes.
- 4) If you are dressed in any part of your uniform, you represent the Concho Valley Chapter of Basketball Officials. Conduct yourself according to all policies.
- 5) Casual dress to and from ball games is acceptable. No shorts, tank tops, or any other items not appropriate as business casual.
- 6) Game uniforms must be neat. Uniforms must be the state required uniform for all Chapter assigned games.
- 7) Regulated items by U.I.L, TASO, and State Laws
 - a. Alcohol – Never to be used prior to the game on game day. Remember the open container law while driving from contests. Never bring an open container onto State Regulated property. This includes current meeting facilities.
 - b. Medication – Alert your crew of any medications that might alter your ability to officiate or be perceived as alcohol.
 - c. Tobacco Products – Use is prohibited on any State Regulated property. This includes current meeting facilities.
- 8) Conduct of an official before, during, and after a game should be strictly professional. All conversations with anyone before, during, or after a game should be limited and professional.
- 9) All reporting of incidents must adhere strictly to the TASO – Basketball reporting procedure. Incidents include, but are not limited to, fan ejection, player ejection, coach ejection, or any incident that occurs that may disrupt the normal proceedings of a game.
- 10) An official shall not place information regarding previous or upcoming assignments to UIL contests, or opinions concerning coaches, players, teams, or administrators for those contests on any social media site or publicly viewed electronic media. Any social media post is subject for review.
- 11) I will provide the Concho Valley Chapter of Basketball Officials Board of Directors notice of any misdemeanor or felony arrest or charge within 48 hours of said incident. This does not include traffic code violations.
